

EF's upcoming Historic Event Tours for D-Day 75 and VE Day 75 will showcase some of EF's most engaging opportunities for experiential learning yet.

Enhanced programming at D-Day 75

Bletchley Park, London:

EF is taking over the site for three days, running custom-designed workshops that will investigate the history of codebreaking and its impact on the outcome of the war.

Jewish Quarter, Amsterdam:

Travellers will participate in a half-day of programming during a guided tour of the Jewish Quarter, including the former deportation site and the Jewish Historical Museum.

Topography of Terror Museum, Berlin:

During an EF-exclusive workshop, travellers will discuss art, media and their role in propaganda, and the use of fear to influence society—throughout history and today.

Juno Beach Centre, Normandy:

EF has developed an exclusive app that works as an inquiry-based tool to explore Juno Park. Plus, on June 6, we'll have a D-Day Hub featuring educational programming and connections with the local community.

Enhanced programming at VE Day 75

Canadian War Cemeteries:

Travellers will attend the official VE Day 75 ceremonies, and EF is coordinating with Canadian and local officials to create opportunities for our travellers to participate.

The Hague, Netherlands:

We're working with local experts and the community to create a series of interactive workshops that focus on peace and conflict in the 21st century.

Bergen op Zoom, Netherlands:

Travellers will work hand-in-hand with the local community to create an installation commemorating Canada's relationship with the Dutch people.

Bastogne War Museum, Belgium:

This interactive workshop will highlight American and civilian experiences to expose travellers to multiple perspectives on the Second World War.
